Action By: June 7, 2014

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed New Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the City of Glendale Material Recovery Facility and Transfer Station, Facility No. 19-AA-1130, located in Los Angeles County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on April 3, 2014. Action must be taken on this permit no later than June 7, 2014. If no action is taken by June 7, 2014 the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed new SWFP.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the City of Glendale Material Recovery Facility and Transfer Station, Facility No. 19-AA-1130, as proposed.
