

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief approve the renewal of a Minor Waste Tire Storage Facility Permit for TJT, Inc., Yolo County – Facility TPID No. 1006689. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.


Staff received an application for a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit on December 7, 2010. The application was accepted on December 30, 2010. CalRecycle is required to act by June 28, 2011.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in 14 CCR, section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are in the facility file.
