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**Summary of Request:** This is a request that the Program Director approve the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Storage Facilities Permit for reRubber, LLC. San Bernardino County – TPID No. 1554413. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

Staff received an application for a Minor Waste Tire Facilities Permit on November 16, 2009. The application was accepted on November 23, 2009. CalRecycle is not required to act until May 23, 2010.

**Recommendation:** Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in 14 CCR 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Facilities Permit. The required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are in the facility file.
