
Introduction

- **San Bernardino County**
 - **Over 20,000 square miles in size**
 - **1.7 million population**
 - **Could fit four states inside its boundaries**

Operations

- **Regional between County and 23 cities**
- **E-waste, CESQG and Material Re-use**
- **Latex paint recycling and distribution**
- **\$2.3 million Budget**
- **Central vs. Satellite facilities**

Waste Volume

- **2.3 million pounds waste**
 - **31,014 participants and 141 CESQGs**
- **Latex paint was 15%, (340,048 pounds)**
- **Oil base paint was 13%**
 - **Does not include amount waste exchanged**
 - **Approximately 2.5%**

Latex Paint Cost

- **\$160 per 55-gallon drum**
- **Approximately 30 cents per pound with drum**
 - **340,048 X .30 cents = \$102,014**
- **Does not include collection, bulking,
transportation or overhead**

Historic Relationships

- **Program distributes paint for graffiti abatement**
 - **Cities and non-profit Organizations**
- **Program purchases paint @ \$9.40 per 5-gallon bucket**
 - **Ugly used buckets**
- **Recycling one 55-gallon drum increases to \$263**

Historic Problems

- **Demand from Cities and non-profit agencies depends on the aggressiveness of taggers**
 - **Leads to overstocking and/or under-stocking**
- **Negative impact on customer service**
- **Spoilt paint**

Birth of on-Site Recycling Project

- **MLA project**
- **Buy-in from key staff**
- **Visit to Kern County**
- **Purchase equipment**
 - **\$2090**
- **Labor and Equipment**
 - **\$6,242**


