On October 6, 2006, the Governing Board of the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) adopted Rule 410 – Odors from Transfer Stations and Material Recovery Facilities. Rule 410 requires owners or operators of facilities subject to the rule to submit either a SCAQMD-approved Rule 410 Odor Management Plan or a Local Enforcement Agency-approved Alternative Odor Management Plan (AOMP) by January 1, 2008.
