

Regulatory Approach for Green Waste

Green waste (and other regulated articles) is prohibited from moving **out** of the Asian Citrus Psyllid (ACP) quarantine area except if moved under a **special permit.**

Special Permit issued by California Department of Food & Agriculture (CDFA) to:

- ◆ Businesses that move **processed** green waste out of the ACP quarantine area
- ◆ Businesses that move **unprocessed** green waste out of quarantine area
- ◆ Businesses **outside** the ACP quarantine area that **receive** green waste (processed or unprocessed) from inside the ACP quarantine area.

Who doesn't need a permit?

- ◆ Businesses that **do not move** green waste (processed or unprocessed) out of quarantine area
- ◆ Final processors of green waste located inside the ACP quarantine area
- ◆ Businesses that do not handle any green waste host material.

Permit Conditions

For green waste **movers**:

- Agree to adhere to processing method (if applicable)
- Agree to only move green waste out of the quarantine area to approved receivers
- Agree to only move green waste out of the quarantine area in an enclosed vehicle
- Agree to allow project staff on site to ensure compliance with above conditions and review records.

Permit Conditions (continued)

For green waste **receivers**:

- Agree to receive green waste from approved shippers
- Agree to adhere to approved processing method
- Agree to have traps placed on property
- Agree to allow inspectors on-site to ensure compliance with above conditions and review records.

Next Steps for CDFA:

- ◆ Review questionnaires.
- ◆ Work with industry to finalize permit conditions (*practical and enforceable solutions*)
- ◆ Contact businesses to issue permit documents as necessary.
