Please be advised that the California Integrated Waste Management Board (Board) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for East Stockton Transfer & Recycling Station. The Board enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the City of Stockton, including all active and closed sites.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

East Stockton Transfer & Recycling Station is an approximately 2.7-acre transfer and processing facility located at 2435 East Weber Avenue in the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County, approximately 1,000 feet north of Highway 4. On August 20, 2007, the Board Enforcement Agent (EA) received from East Stockton

Transfer & Recycling Station, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the RFI. The applicant requested a change in: description of recyclable sorting process; addition of sorting line equipment; description of water use for the wood processing operation; Figure 2 Site Plan, Figure 3 Site Plan drainage, and Figure 5 Site Plan Waste/Recyclables Flow. The Operators consideration for changes to the RFI include reduction of potential impacts on labor, increased efficiency of construction and demolition materials recycling process, increased material recovery for the municipality, and preparation for any future recycling mandates. No other change to the SWFP is under consideration at this time.

The EA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on August 27, 2007.
