Background: L and D Landfill currently holds a Solid Waste Facility Permit (34-AA-0020) that permits inert landfill disposal and transfer processing (MRF) operations. On November, 23, 2011, L and D Landfill submitted an application to the LEA to revise the Solid Waste Facility Permit to allow for a vertical expansion of waste and extend closure from 2013 to 2023. The application was accepted as incomplete on December 1, 2011 pending development of a Non-water Corrective Action Plan and accepted as complete and correct on June 20, 2012.

The Sacramento County Division of Environmental Review and Assessment (DERA) prepared a Negative Declaration (Neg Dec), Control Number 2012-70013, on behalf of the LEA.

Purpose of Meeting: To provide information to the public on the Solid Waste Facility Permit, pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (14CCR), Section 21660 et seq., and to provide information regarding the Neg Dec.

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento, enforcing state laws and regulations at Solid Waste Facilities, including landfills. The LEA acted as the lead agency for the development of the Neg Dec for the proposed facility. The Neg Dec was prepared by the Division of Environmental Review and Assessment (DERA), at the LEA's behest.

The Public Hearing will be held concurrently with the Public Informational Meeting for the proposed landfill, pursuant to 14 CCR, Section 21660 et seq. The meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed permit and to provide comments regarding the proposed action.

A summary of the comments from the meeting and any written comments received by the LEA will be included with the permit application package that will be submitted to CalRecycle for concurrence or rejection at a public meeting. If you wish to be notified of the CalRecycle meeting, please notify the LEA in writing, no later than **July 18, 2012**.

Project Description:

The Applicant proposes and the proposed revised facility permit would allow the following design and operational changes:

- Vertical elevation of waste would increase from 85' to 97'(MSL)
- Landfill closure would be extended from 2013 to 2023
- Permitted boundary would be reduced to eliminate parcels to the north of the main facility
