**Notice of Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) Application for  
Rice Road Recyclery and Transfer Station**

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, in compliance with Public Resources Code 44004 and Title 27 California Code of Regulations (CCR), that the County of Fresno, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application on **December 28, 2012** for the Rice Road Recyclery and Transfer Station. The facility is located at 10463 N. Rice Road, Fresno, CA and the SWFP number is 10-AA-0145. The purpose of the informational meeting is to make public the preliminary determination of the action to be taken by the LEA on the SWFP application package.

On **December 28, 2012** the Fresno County Public Health Department, Environmental Health Division, acting as the LEA received a SWFP application package for the Rice Road Recyclery and Transfer Station. The SWFP application package was accepted on **January 27, 2013**. The LEA's preliminary determination is that the proposed SWFP application package meets the requirements of Title 27 CCR 21570.

The SWFP application will address the following operations:

- Maximum of 400 tons per day (not changing)
- Facility operating hours-Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Maximum of 195 incoming vehicles per day (not changing)
- This facility does not accept garbage, highly putrescible wastes, liquid wastes, dead animals, paint, sludges or hazardous wastes (not changing).
- Eliminating of the buy-back center and aluminum, glass, and plastic bottle processing operation
- Discontinuation of sorting and bailing activities, removal of some equipment

A copy of the SWFP application package is on file and available for public review from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Fresno County Department of Public Health, Environmental Health Division, located at 1221 Fulton Mall, Fresno CA 93721. The informational meeting will take place on **Friday March 22, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the Woodward Park Regional Library, Woodward Park Meeting Room located at 944 E. Perrin Ave, Fresno, CA**.
