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**Introduction**

Please be advised that the Alameda County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for Altamont Landfill & Resource Recovery Facility (ALRRF). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recovery and Recycling (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the Alameda County.

**Description of project and LEA's determination**

The Project Applicant, Waste Management of Alameda County, Inc., currently operates a solid waste facility on a 2170 acres parcel (excluding area of easements). Waste disposal operations at the ALRRF from 1980 to the present have been conducted in an area referred to as Fill Area 1 (FA1). A lateral expansion of the landfill into an area referred to as Fill Area 2 (FA2) was approved in March 2000. FA1 is approximately 235 acres in plan size. Approximately 250 permitted acres (plan area), designated as FA2, have been granted a conditional use permit (CUP) to accept Class II and Class III wastes. This facility is located at 10840 Altamont Pass Road, Livermore, CA 94551. On January 11, 2011, the LEA received from ALRRF, a SWFP application package to amend the RFI requesting to update the document to:

- Adjust the posted hours as allowed within the limits of the listed entitled hours from the Environmental Impact Report (EIR).
- Update the RFI pursuant to the changes requested in the 5 Year Permit Review Report dated August 20, 2010.
- Update the Joint Technical Document (JTD) to include current environmental permits.

No other change to the SWFP is under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with the California Department of Resources, Recovery and Recycling State Minimum Standards, and is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents. The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current SWFP. The LEA approved the amendment on February 10, 2011.
