**Summary of Request:** This is a request that the Branch Chief approve the issuance of a New Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit (WTFP) for TireCore International, LTD, TPID No. 1855211, located in the City of Santa Fe Springs, Los Angeles County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

Staff initially received an application for a New Minor WTFP on May 3, 2016, with amendments received on May 23, 2016 and May 27, 2016. The application was accepted as complete and correct on June 2, 2016. CalRecycle is required to act by November 29, 2016.

**Recommendation:** Based on staff's review of the submitted permit application package, staff recommends issuance of the Minor WTFP. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a New Minor WTFP. These findings are summarized in the table found in the attached Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are maintained by the Waste Permitting, Compliance, and Mitigation Division. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report.
