RE: Boomers El Cajon - Beneficial Reuse Exemption for tires per Title 14, CCR 17346(f)

Mrs. Rosales,

Boomers El Cajon is located at 1155 Graves Avenue, El Cajon Ca. We are seeking a beneficial reuse exemption for tires per Title 14, CCR 17346(f) for our go-kart track. Attached you will find the required information. The used tires provide a sound and economical source for shock absorption of go-karts that may veer off the race track. Compared to the cost of air bags, or the debris left on the track by hay bales, tires offer an effective, safe, and economic alternative.

You will find enclosed:

- 1) Letter from the City of El Cajon Planning Department stating the use of the tires as barriers is approved under the current City of El Cajon approved permits.
- 2) Letter from the City of El Cajon Building and Fire Safety which states that the department has no object to the plan to use tires as a barrier system.
- 3) Letter from the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health – Vector Control Program showing there is no evidence of mosquito breeding for beneficial reuse of tires for the barrier system.
- 4) Letter from Philippe Lalonde, California Licensed Civil Engineer evaluating used tires as the best safety barrier system suited to the needs of Boomers El Cajon go-kart track operations.
