On behalf of the Greater South San Joaquin Valley Recycling Market Development Zone the Economic Development Corporation serving Tulare County and the Kings County Economic Development Corporation respectfully submit this 2003 Expansion Application to merge the Greater South San Joaquin Valley RMDZ with the Porterville RMDZ. We further ask your consideration in renewing the Greater South San Joaquin Valley RMDZ when it is due to expire in March 2004.
