

Dey Pharma, L.P. Plan for Supporting Safe Collection and Disposal of Waste Devices

Based upon Dey Pharma, L.P.'s ("Dey or Company") good faith understanding and interpretation of Cal. Pub. Res. Code 47115, Dey has prepared this Plan to Support the Safe Collection and Disposal of Waste Devices (this "Plan"). This Plan is applicable to two of Dey's products – EpiPen® and EpiPen® Jr Auto Injectors.

- Dey provides written information detailing the proper disposal of the EpiPen and EpiPen Jr Auto-Injectors in its Medication Guide ("Guide") which is contained in every trade package distributed by Company. This information is included in every trade package
- The EpiPen and EpiPen Jr Guide and Prescribing Information are provided in patient starter kits and are readily accessible to patients, caregivers, physicians and other persons electronically on the Dey website (www.dey.com) and the EpiPen and EpiPen Jr Auto-Injector website (www.epipen.com). In addition, it is Dey's understanding that additional copies of the Guide are provided to patients with the dispensing of each prescription by the applicable pharmacy.
- The Guide directs patients to dispose of used auto-injectors by taking them to the hospital or to their physician after use.
- The Dey Customer Service Department staff have been trained to relay the information contained in the Guide to patients that seek information regarding the disposal of the EpiPen and EpiPen Jr Auto-Injector.
- Our Guide also describes the process for disposal of expired units by transporting the unit to a hospital or a physician's office.
