## Notice to Amend the Joint Technical Document

Kiefer Landfill

February 5, 2014

### **Introduction**

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA received and approved an amendment to the Joint Technical Document (JTD) for Kiefer Landfill.

### **Description of project and LEA's determination**

Kiefer Landfill is a disposal site located at 12701 Kiefer Blvd in Sloughouse, CA. On January 15, 2014, the LEA received an application package to amend the Joint Technical Document (JTD), as required by the Five Year Permit Review Report issued on November 18, 2013. The updates are as follows:

- Corrected relevant sections to reflect the accurate permitted daily/peak tonnage;
- Added information on noise control measures and complaint response protocol;
- Updated the Landfill Gas Control and Monitoring Plan to be consistent with CalRecycle's landfill gas screening procedures and to include the recently installed extraction wells;
- Updated the Solid Waste Acceptance Policy to prevent the acceptance of hazardous material;
- Included information on the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District's requirements for the discharge of leachate to the POTW.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards contained in Title 14 and Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on February 5, 2014.
