The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a Public Informational Meeting for a new proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit for City of Glendale Material Recovery Facility and Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction.

Description of Project

- City of Glendale Recycling and Buyback Center is an existing operation at the above project location. In order for the City to meet increased State waste diversion mandates, the City is proposing to expand its operation to start receiving and processing non-hazardous material, which includes 250 tons per day of mixed municipal solid waste as well as source separated recyclable material from multi-family and commercial sources.
- Proposed time for waste receiving, processing and transfer is Monday through Sunday, 24 hours per day.
- In 2013 the City circulated and approved a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the change in operation.

Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Informational Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed new permit and to provide comments to the LEA. The meeting is strictly informational and **no official decision will be made at the meeting** regarding the formal determination on the solid waste facility permit application.
